## **FVHCA UNIFORM BACKGROUND CHECK REQUIREMENTS:**

ALL of the checks below are required, and must be performed and cleared without criminal record. ANY positive findings must be discussed between the school and clinical faculty and permission from the healthcare facility granted for the student to proceed with clinical placement. Students – if you have any questions regarding these checks, please work with your school coordinator/faculty for more information.

- 1. Background Information Disclosure Form (BID)

  - b. Required annually and within 48 hours of any change in status
- 2. Department of Justice Criminal Background Check/Department of Health and Family Services (DHFS) Caregiver Background Check

  - b. Click on the "Public Access" tab; under background request, click on "Submit Request." Once you read the security warning, check the accept box, and continue. For "Background Request Type," use drop down arrow to select "Caregiver." Fill in the required fields and click continue (note background check report is required).
- 3. Health and Human Services (HHS) Office of the Inspector General Exclusions Check

- 4. System for Award Management (SAM) (formerly EPLS) Check:

For the following items, regulatory approval, employment as a caregiver, and non-client residency at and contracting with an entity are prohibited until rehabilitation approval is received, for all entities and programs that serve any clients who are under the age of 18.
